Music

We will be listening to music - finding the pulse, identifying instruments and clapping rhythms. We will be singing and rapping!

History

In History, we will develop our understanding of the past and how we find out about the past. Reception will begin to make sense of their own life-story and will look at Dinosaurs, whilst Year 1 will learn about significant figures from the past – Mary Anning (dinosaur link) & Florence Nightingale.

Art – Drawing – textures and rubbings – reception. Line and tone – year 1. Media explorations -working with different lines in different drawing media. Looking at various artists such as Van Gogh for inspiration.

- We use known phonemes to read, develop our understanding of the text and improve intonations when we read out loud.
