## **Staffing Update**

I am delighted to let you know that we have secured two permanent teachers to join the Fowlmere Family in Kingfishers from January 2023. Mrs Barker will be teaching from Monday to Thursday and has many years of experience teaching in local schools. Her father was also a pupil at the school in the 1950's and was even taught in the Kingfisher's classroom! She has substantial leadership experience, particularly in maths, which is a great additional to our team. Mrs Walsh will join the class on a Friday, but will also be our in-school tutor, as well as our Forest School practitioner for the whole school, leading on the re-development of our nature area in the back playground. We will be creating an opportunity for Kingfisher parents to meet with them soon.
