## **Key Stage 2 Production**

### **End-of-Year Reports**

This year's reports will go home on Wednesday 11th July. Please look out for them...

Changes to the statutory assessment frameworks for Year 2 and Year 6 means that one area of assessment (eg handwriting) should not affect an overall judgement of meeting the expected standard, and so we have made a parallel change to our inschool system so that a single missed criteria does not stop a child achieving the expected standard. I will include more information on this with the reports.

This year the school has taken part in local authority moderation for Reception assessments and has had a moderation visit for Year 2. These visits are on a cycle. We were last moderated for Year 6 in 2016 and visited to verify Year 6 SATs in 2017.

### **Kwik Cricket**

Ten children from Class 3 took part in the Year 3/4 Kwik Cricket competition at Caldecote Cricket Club yesterday. We played four matches in our pool, beating Guilden Morden, but losing to Swavesey A, Jeavons Wood and Elsworth.
