Dinosaurs in Class 2...

This week saw Class 2 visiting the Sedgwick Museum in Cambridge to explore the topic of dinosaurs. Nicola from the museum led a session about fossils and challenged pupils to think about where they thought a small piece of bone she showed them had come from on the skeleton, mirroring the kind of puzzle palaeontologists are having to solve all the time. Spelling

As part of our commitment to improving spelling across the school, we will be introducing some additional spelling work to be completed as part of your child's home learning. It is our hope that this will be a quick and simple addition that has positive impact on spelling.

Each week your child will have five 'tricky' words to learn using a method of their choice.
