As we settle into the new school year, the children are all settling into their new topics.

Children in Starling Class are focusing on Dinosaurs this term, with Year 1 children learning about Mary Anning and Florence Nightingale. Within the science curriculum, the children are learning about forces and changes in the natural world.

In the Goldfinch Class they are learning all about the different types of rocks and soils.

For history, they are focusing on Ancient Egypt.

The Owl Class are developing their understanding of forces and space, with a specific focus on the movement of Earth, planets and the moon. Their learning in history is linked to the Stone Age and Iron Age, where they will be using primary sources to deduce information.
