Home Learning:

No formal written homework set.

Research-based evidence shows that written homework is ineffective in early primary phase.

Daily reading, phonics, spelling, counting & times tables practise at home is essential.

- Hear your child read every day
- Talk about what they have read to check understanding
- Practise everyday maths skills counting, number bonds, measuring, weighing, estimating, shapes etc. to build fluency
- Play games & do puzzles to build concentration & for fun!
